

## Murrieta

The City of Murrieta was the largest beneficiary of the Pechanga Band’s economic activities within the district. The majority of the city lies within the district. There were 318 residents of the district and Murrieta employed either by the Tribe or the Pechanga Resort and Casino in 2003. These individuals received wages, benefits and other payments equal to \$8,527,352. In addition, the Tribe was responsible for \$1,802,641 in purchases of goods and services from Murrieta suppliers located in the district. The Tribe’s activities resulted in the indirect employment of 538 people receiving wages of \$15,102,793. Indirect purchases of \$4,194,385 worth of goods and services occurred in Murrieta and the district as the result of the Tribe’s activities.

The total indirect and direct effects of the Tribe’s activities accounted for 856 jobs being created in Murrieta within District 45. These jobs paid \$23,630,145 in wages and benefits. In addition, the Tribe’s activities resulted in the purchase of goods and services worth \$5,997,026 from local suppliers.
