
The Do's and Don't of Pesticides

Do

Identify the issue.

Use Proper Protective Wear


It is important to wear gloves, long sleeves or other protective wear. Read the label on the pesticide to find out what you should use.



Do

Dispose of Properly

Pesticides are a hazardous chemical and should be disposed of properly. Do not throw in the garbage, unless specified on the label.



Don't

Overuse product.

When applying pesticides in your home, use the correct amount identified on label.
Overusing product may seem like a good idea but you may be harming your household.




Don't

Leave out food.

Pests are attracted to food and water sources. When you leave these out you could be inviting them into your home.

Make sure you put away your food and stop any water leaks to reduce opportunity for pests to enter your home.



Don't

Leave Pesticides Out

Pesticide storage is very important for the health and safety of your household. This will also prolong the life of your product. Read the label for proper storage information. You may need to lock cabinets in case you have children or pets. Leaving pesticides in the sunlight may break down the product and make it less effective.
